

Lower Zambezi 3 day 2 night safari

THIS EXTRAORDINARILY BEAUTIFUL PARK IS LOCATED BETWEEN THE ROLLING HILLS OF THE ZAMBEZI ESCARPMENT AND THE ZAMBEZI RIVER. SITUATED OPPOSITE THE FLOOD PLAINS OF THE MANA POOLS NATIONAL PARK IN ZIMBABWE. OUR FIVE DAY, FOUR NIGHT MOBILE CAMPING SAFARI IS ONE OF THE FEW SAFARIS IN AFRICA THAT OFFERS SUCH A WIDE RANGE OF ACTIVITIES. FROM THE FAMOUS ZAMBIAN GAME WALKS, NIGHT DRIVES, MORNING AND AFTERNOON DRIVES, RIVER CRUISE TO THE THRILL OF CANOEING DOWN ONE OF THE MOST BEAUTIFUL STRETCHES THAT THE ZAMBEZI RIVER HAS TO OFFER.

Day 1

Leave Lusaka Airport about 14:00 and head to the Lower Zambezi Game Management Area this is about a 40 minute flight. You are met by the guide and transferred to the camp. After settling in to the camp, there is the option of a sunset river cruise or just relax in the camp and watch the sunset from the bar..

Day 2

We'll get up early and after breakfast, head off for a mornings canoe safari. We will head for the Chifungulu Channel, where we will be met by our game viewing car for lunch. Lunch is spent at a safe and scenic location, where we spend a couple of hours here out of the heat just relaxing and watching the game as they come down to drink from the river. After lunch we do an head off for an afternoons game drive. The cool of the afternoon is a good time to spot the predators, as they prefer to hunt in the cooler parts of the day. Arriving at a great sundowners spot to watch the Sunset. We then go on an hour or so night drive keeping our eyes open for the night hunters, such as Lion and Leopard as well as many other nocturnal such as Porcupine, Civet and Genet, returning back to our camp for dinner.

Day 3

Up early again for a two or three hour game walk in the Game Management Area, the game walk is a great experience, our guide and armed scout show us how to identify different types of spoor and droppings, also they'll teach you about the medicinal and spiritual uses of the many different plants and trees. We leave about 10:00 for our return trip to Lusaka, stopping at an island for lunch and arrive back in Lusaka at about 17:00.

Costs.

This is an all inclusive price of £301 per person.

Departure Dates.

This trip departs from Lusaka every Monday and Wednesday. Special dates can be arranged for groups of 6 or more.

Other Information.

Accommodation is in Chalets with all bedding provided.

Included are: all park fees, food and camping equipment. We will supply mineral water and filtered drinking water.

Not included: Soft drinks, wine and beers; Transfers to and from the point of departure for the trip, unless pre arranged by your agent
